**Phil Stover Receives the Endorsement of Educators
for the N.C. House District 7 Legislative Seat**

RALEIGH, N.C. – Educators have endorsed *Phil Stover* for the N.C. House District 7 legislative seat in the North Carolina General Assembly. He would represent citizens in Franklin County and part of Nash County.

Issues important to Stover include education, high-quality healthcare, systemic racism, and economic development. “Public education is the bedrock of our democracy,” Stover said. “Our educational system has been failing our children, and that must stop!”
